EBI IN ANIMAL SHELTERS

The Kentucky Board of Veterinary Examiners presents *Euthanasia by Injection* training for animal shelter and animal control workers. This workshop meets the training requirements for the Animal Euthanasia Specialist license in the State of Kentucky. **Registration is limited to those working in companion animal welfare and control.**

In this workshop, you'll learn about euthanasia and sedation drugs, anatomy, restraint, injection techniques, equipment, safety, and legal requirements. Instruction will be through lecture, discussion, videos, and a wet lab.

Tuition is \$200. Your tuition covers a meal both days and 16 hours of professional classroom and hands-on training. You also receive a comprehensive workbook and other materials. To receive the required certificate of completion, candidates must attend the entire workshop both days, achieve 70% or higher on the workshop exam, and participate in the wet lab.
